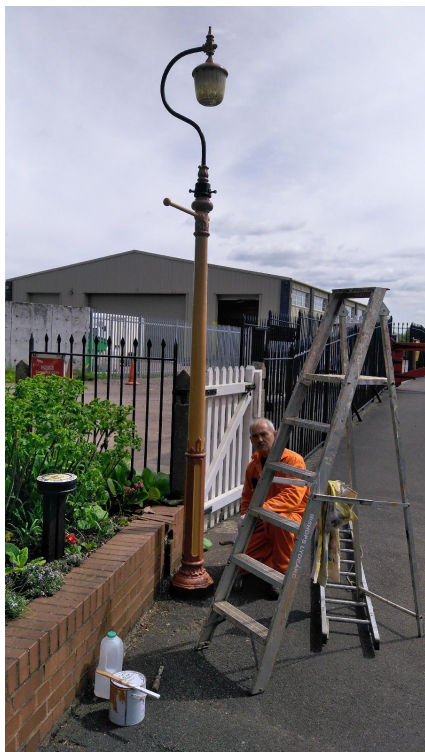
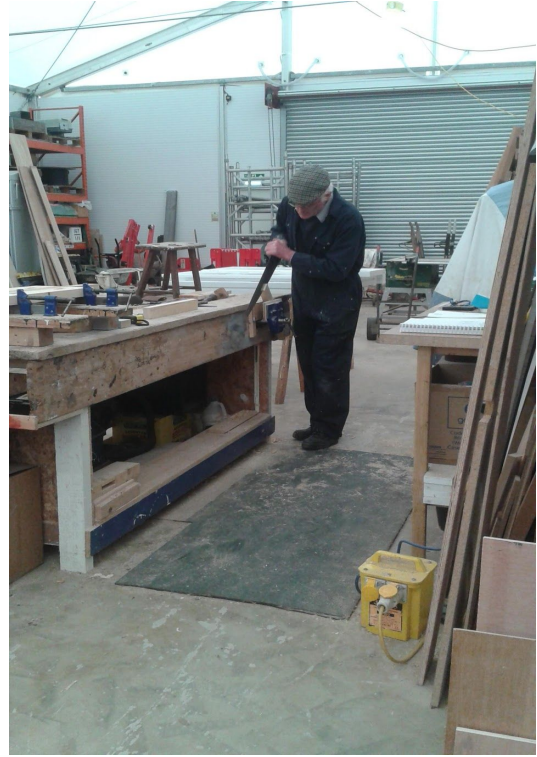
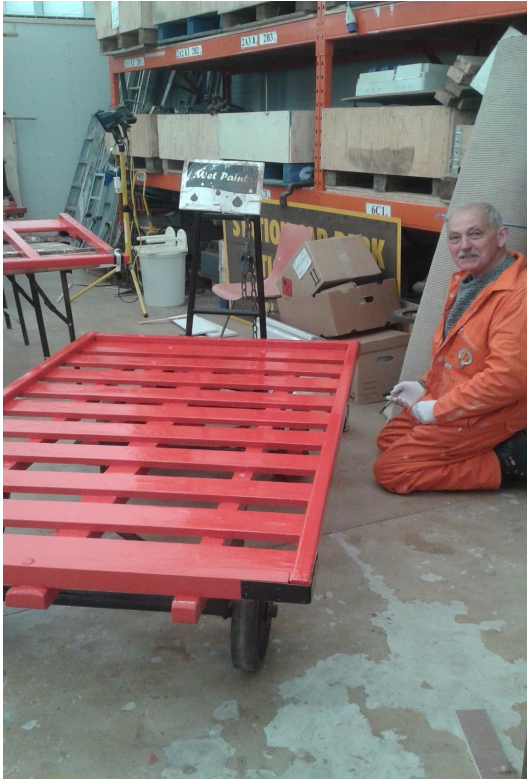

**JOB PURPOSE:** Maintain the Railway's stations, buildings, furniture and surrounding areas. Repairing gates, doors, signs, refurbishing offices, station seats and lots of painting!

#### **RESPONSIBILITIES & DUTIES:**

- Carrying out carpentry, painting and building work as directed by the Foreman.
- Responsible for looking after WSR equipment and returning after use.
- Reporting any defects found with the tools issued.
- Aged 16 years and over

#### **PERSONAL SKILLS**

- Physically fit to lift and carry tools
- Work individually or as a team on practical applications.
- Enjoy practical work - painting/woodworking/construction - but no particular skills necessary - training on the job.

#### **TRAINING / COMPETENCY REQUIRED**

- No formal training require
- PTS - only if access to the trackside is required as part of the work (optional 1/2 day)

#### **COMMITMENT TO VOLUNTEERING**

The team meet in Bishops Lydeard on Monday Wednesday and Friday – approx. 09:30 – 15:30. Volunteers are expected to sign on to work at least once per month at any session.

Volunteers who carry out twelve days/shifts per year are eligible to free travel on the railway and other perks, such as refreshments and discounts in WSR outlets.
